Since all of the items are worded as positive statements, a higher number reflects a more positive response from the student.
Example:

My degree has prepared me to enter jobs in my field.

A response of "5" would mean that the student "strongly agrees" with the statement, which reflects positively on the major, department, and college

Conversely, a response of "1" would indicate that the student "strongly disagrees" with the statement.
